Proposition 50 Grant Proposal, Step 2**

**Attachment 14: Changes from Step 1 to Step 2**

*In Attachment 14, the applicant must clearly identify and discuss differences between the Step 1 and Step 2. In general, those differences must be limited to necessary modifications to improve the IRWMP Plan or Proposal, changes needed to reduce the grant request to \$25 million, and changes to schedules that reflect revised information. The applicant must ensure that the changes to the IRWMP Plan or Proposal maintain or improve the quality of the application. DWR and the State Water Board will make a determination of continued eligibility for an implementation grant. Attachment 14 must be no more than 10 pages in length using a minimum 10-point type font.*

*As applicable, the application must detail changes to the following:*

- *Applicant – In the event the applicant has changed, please identify the Step 1 applicant name and the basis for the change.*
- *Consolidated Regions – In the event that regions, as presented in Step 1, have been consolidated in Step 2, please discuss how the separate IRWMP Plans and Proposals that were evaluated in Step 1 were consolidated or coordinated to ensure effective water management for the consolidated region.*
- *Changes in Region Boundaries – If the region boundaries have changed since the Step 1 application, describe the changes and the reason for the changes. In addition, submit GIS files that describe the new regional boundary. The GIS files should be submitted together in a zip file. GIS files must include as a minimum those files with file extensions of “shp”, “shx”, “dbf”, and “prj.” The region boundaries will be used by DWR and the State Water Board to locate and display the IRWMP regions that the various applicants have established. - *Disadvantaged Communities – Submit only information that is required to document the changes from the Step 1 application. This includes, but is not limited to, explanation, data, or calculation; however, there is no requirement to resubmit all data or calculations from Step 1. Supply enough information so that the reviewers can understand the changes and impacts of those changes in terms of disadvantaged communities.*

Since the submittal of the Step 1 Proposal, several changes to the Proposal have been made, as requested by the State. These changes include a consolidation of the Calleguas Creek Watershed Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) Region and the Ventura Countywide IRWMP Region and a reduction of the funding request to a combined total of \$25 million. The Step 2 Proposal includes the following types of changes from the Step 1 Proposal:

- Applicant and Consolidated Region
- Region Boundaries
- Project List

Applicant and Consolidated Region

For this Step 2 Proposal, the applicant is the Watersheds Coalition of Ventura County (WCVC), which is comprised of all participating entities from the two separate Step 1 Proposals from Calleguas Municipal Water District (on behalf of the Calleguas Creek Watershed Management Plan [CCWMP] Steering Committee) and the County of Ventura (on

behalf of the Ventura Countywide Integrated Regional Water Management Plan [VCIRWMP] group). The two groups voluntarily consolidated at the request of the State.

Currently, an IRWMP is being developed to combine the Calleguas Creek Watershed IRWMP adopted by the CCWMP Steering Committee and the Plan that was under development for the VCIRWMP group. The WCVC will ensure effective water management and oversee the development and adoption of the consolidated plan.

Changes in Region Boundaries

The region identified in the Calleguas Step 1 Proposal has been expanded to the region identified in Ventura County's Step 1 Proposal, which is defined by the Ventura County boundaries as shown in Att14\_IG2\_9604\_Changes\_2of2.pdf GIS files used to create the region boundaries figure can be found on the Other Attachments CD-Rom.



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Project List

Due to the consolidation of the two regions and the reduction in maximum funding amount, the projects in the Proposal have been modified. Projects were selected from the funding list based on need, timing, benefits, and cost to the region. In some cases, alternative sources of funding were identified for projects not included in the Step 2 Proposal.

In addition, VCWWD1 Recycled Water System, Phase II (C-7), and the Simi Valley Tapo Canyon

Water Treatment Plant (C-11) have been added to the funding list. These projects were not covered in the Calleguas Creek Watershed IRWMP, but are consistent with the goals and objectives of the IRWMP and will be included in the WCVI IRWMP.

A summary of projects submitted in the Step 1 Proposal as compared to those submitted in this Step 2 Proposal is provided below.
